

How fortunate the gentleman is to have found a subject on which he can lay such honest, heartfelt and unstinting praise. And so often, too. As for myself, I am not quite so enthusiastic. This "Mini Guide" to Massenet's "Manon," and others of the series that have fallen into my hands from time to time, delivers pretty much what it says it will do. If you are actually willing to be satisfied with so small a thing as a CliffsNotes approach to opera, these "Mini Guides" will serve as well as any other--although the asking price strikes me as a bit steep. However, I wish to suggest alternatives. First, haul yourself away from your computer. Then, go out to see the opera. If you don't have an opera company nearby, call up your local college,

university or conservatory and ask what the opera workshop is doing.
