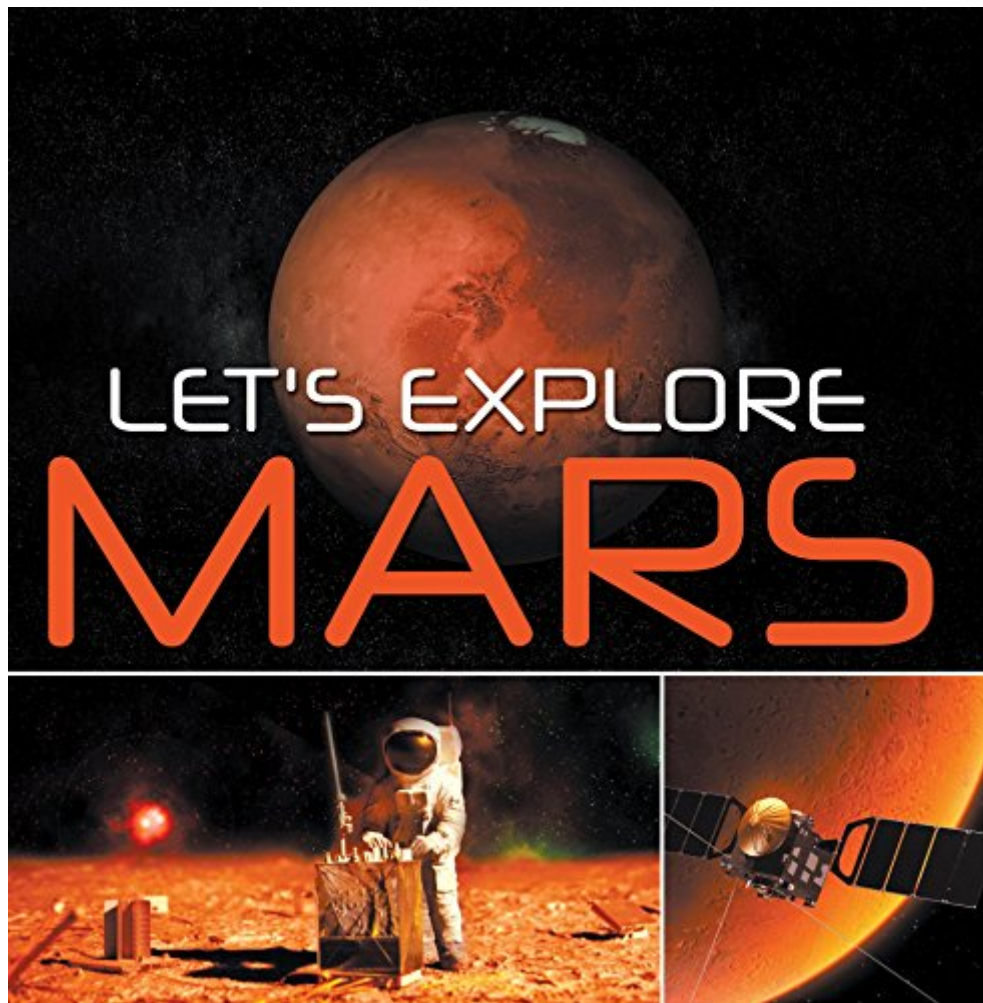

The one thing I do need to point out, is it does repeat itself. In the 18 pages given in the ebook, page 13 and page 17 are the exact same, just the picture is different.
